CBO projections show US Federal debt rising by \$5.2 billion per day for the next 10 years.


However, since the debt ceiling "crisis" came to an end, US debt has jumped by \$30 billion per day.

We have added roughly \$1 trillion per month in US debt since then.


That means EVERY HOUR the US is borrowing \$1.3 billion and paying \$125 million in interest.

What is the (Invisible) Church

Colossians 1:18 - One Body Eph. 2:11-16 – Jew & Gentile united by faith in Christ Acts 15:14 – Why? Calling out a people for His name 1 Cor 12:13 – one Spirit all baptized into one Body Acts 1:5 – Spirit baptism yet future (Day of Pentecost) Not O.T. or Gospel age "believers"

What is a Pre-Tribulation Rapture

Pretribulationism teaches that the Rapture occurs before the Tribulation starts. At that time, the church will meet Christ in the air, and then sometime after that the Antichrist is revealed and the Tribulation begins. In other words, the Rapture and Christ's Second Coming (to set up His kingdom) are separated by at least seven years. According to this view, the church does not experience any of the Tribulation judgments.

What is the Church

The church is composed of all true believers from Pentecost (Acts 2) until the Rapture. The rapture excludes O.T. saints and Tribulation saints.

What is a Pre-Tribulation Rapture

The church is not appointed to wrath (1 Thess. 1:9-10, 5:9), and believers will not be overtaken by the Day of the Lord (1 Thessalonians 5:1-9). The church of Philadelphia was promised to be kept from "the hour of trial that is going to come upon the whole world" (Revelation 3:10).

What is a Pre-Tribulation Rapture

The word "church" appears nineteen times in the first three chapters of Revelation, but, significantly, the word is not used again until chapter 22. In other words, in the entire lengthy description of the Tribulation in Revelation, the word church is noticeably absent.

The Bible never uses the word "church" in a passage relating to the Tribulation.

Distinctions

Pretribulationism is the only theory which clearly maintains the distinction between Israel and the church and God's separate plans for each. The seventy "sevens" of Daniel 9:24 are decreed upon Daniel's people (the Jews) and Daniel's holy city (Jerusalem). This prophecy makes it plain that the seventieth week (the Tribulation) is a time of purging and restoration for Israel and Jerusalem, not for the church.

Distinctions

1 Corinthians 10:32 - Give no occasion of stumbling, either to Jews, or to Greeks, or to the church of God

(Paul makes a distinction between groups)

Historical Support

John 21:22-23: the early church viewed Christ's return as imminent, that He could return at any moment. Otherwise, the rumor would not have persisted that Jesus would return within John's lifetime. Imminence, which is incompatible with the other two Rapture theories, is a key tenet of pretribulationism.

Didache

The Didache: (non-canonical) 70-100 AD. Claimed to be the work of the twelve Apostles. A sort of church manual for early Christians.

Chapter 16: "Watch for your life's sake. Let not your lamps be quenched, nor your loins unloosed; but be ready, for you know not the hour in which our Lord will come."

Irenaeus (AD 130 to 202)

Against Heresies, Book 5, Chapter 29, Irenaeus wrote this about Jesus' return for his church:

"And therefore, when in the end the Church shall be suddenly caught (Gr. Harpazo) up from this, it is said, 'There shall be tribulation such as has not been since the beginning, neither shall be."

Three (3) Key Rapture Passages

John 14:1-3 1 Cor. 15:51-54 1 Thess. 4:13-18

John 14:1-3

1 "Do not let your heart be troubled; believe in God, believe also in Me.

2 In My Father's house are many rooms; if that were not so, I would have told you, because I am going there to prepare a place for you.

John 14:1-3

3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I am coming again and will take you to Myself, so that where I am, there you also will be.

No courtship – arranged – betrothal a legal contract Father & Son agree on the purchase price Father and the Bride discuss the dowry price If agreed: bride and groom drink cup of wine Groom leaves- goes to Father's estate (prepare place) Groom & Bride are "sealed" in this room for 7 days Father approves when building is complete Sends Son to collect His Bride

Bride expected to wait faithfully

Kept oil lamp ready

During her waiting the Bride is referred to as:

- 1) consecrated
- 2) set apart
- 3) bought with a price

Had to wear a veil in public (modesty)

Veil removed when Bridegroom comes

Assembled Bridesmaids – each with lamps Men would routinely "tease" the Groom by continually asking, "when's the honeymoon?" His reply, "only my Father knows" When Father approves, Groom and "friends" set out Usually at night (no interference, surprise arrival) Bride was being 'abducted' – snatched away Had to always be ready

When Groom arrived, He couldn't just 'rush' in 'Friends' had to announce, "the Bridegroom cometh" They would blow horns announcing arrival Neighbors awakened – knew the marriage finally arrived Arrive at New house – the door is shut (sealed) Gifts presented to Bride

Marriage Supper (Rev. 19) comes after that – invited guests

Hebrew Marriage Customs

This is not the

"Bridal Paradigm" taught by

I.H.O.P. International House of Prayer (and others)

- The Ketubah: Espousal (2 Corinthians 11:2; Isa 61:10; Judges 14:10-11; Jer 2:32; Isa 49:18; Ps 45:8-15):
- The Dowry: Payment of the purchase price; set apart (Ephesians 5:25-27 sanctification)
- Bridegroom Builds a House: departs to Father's House: Prepares room addition; bride prepares for his imminent return. (John 14:1-3)

• Huppah: Wedding: Surprise gathering (1 Thess 4:16-17; Jer 7:34; 16:9; 25:10; Ps 45:8-15; Mt 25:1-13).

• Marriage supper: 7-days (Judg 14:12; Mt 9:15; 22:11-14; Jn 2:1).

Marriage Ceremony

Revelation 19:6-8 — The wedding announcement will be made (v. 6), and the Bride will finally be made ready (v. 7). The reason the Bride will now be fully ready for the marriage ceremony is because she will have on her entire bridal gown (v. 8). This bridal gown is said to be the righteous acts of the saints. This teaches us two things. First, it shows that the process of sanctification will indeed be completed, for all that will be showing on the Bride will be her righteous acts.

Marriage Ceremony

Revelation 19:6-8 — Secondly, this also shows that the marriage ceremony takes place after the Judgment Seat of the Messiah when the saints are rewarded for their deeds on earth (1 Cor. 3:10–15). All the wood, hay, and stubble will have been burned away and all the gold, silver, and precious stones will have been purified.

A bema was a raised platform on which judges sat to view athletic games. Their job was to make sure contestants followed the rules and to present awards to the victors (see 1 Corinthians 9:24–27). The bema was never a place to reprimand the athletes or to punish them in any way. It was a place of testing and reward. In the same way, the bema of Christ will not be a place of condemnation or censure.

1 Cor. 3:10-15 — Each one should build with care. For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ. If anyone builds on this foundation using gold, silver, costly stones, wood, hay or straw, their work will be shown for what it is, because the Day will bring it to light. It will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test the quality of each person's work. If what has been built survives, the builder will receive a reward. If it is burned up, the builder will suffer loss but yet will be saved—even though only as one escaping through the flames

1 Cor. 4:5 — Therefore judge nothing before the appointed time; wait until the Lord comes. He will bring to light what is hidden in darkness and will expose the motives of the heart. At that time each will receive their praise from God.

2 Cor. 5:9-10 — So we make it our goal to please him, whether we are at home in the body or away from it. 10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each of us may receive what is due us for the things done while in the body, whether good or bad.

Marriage Feast

Revelation 19:9 – Since many are bidden or invited to come to the marriage feast, this passage indicates that the marriage supper or feast will be at a different place than the marriage ceremony. We know from the Word of God that the Old Testament saints are not resurrected with the Church before the Tribulation, but at the end of the Tribulation (Dan. 12:2).

Marriage Feast

Revelation 19:9 – John the Baptist, who was the last of the Old Testament prophets, called himself a friend of the bridegroom and did not consider himself to be a member of the Bride of the Messiah, the Church (Jn. 3:27–30). Hence, the "many" who are bidden [to attend] the marriage supper on earth are all the Old Testament saints and the Tribulation saints resurrected after the Second Coming of Jesus the Messiah.

1 Cor. 15:50-54

Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption. Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

1 Cor. 15:50-54

For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory. O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?

Mystery

- Mystery (musterion): a hidden or secret thing, not obvious to the understanding . . .
- a. hidden purpose or counsel, deliberately veiled by God only to be revealed by Him
- b. the secret counsels which are hidden from ungodly and wicked men but plain to the godly.

1 Thess. 4:13-18

But we do not want you to be uninformed, brothers and sisters, about those who are asleep, so that you will not grieve as indeed the rest of mankind do, who have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose from the dead, so also God will bring with Him those who have fallen asleep through Jesus. 15 For we say this to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord will not precede those who have fallen asleep.

1 Thess. 4:13-18

For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive, who remain, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord. Therefore, comfort one another with these words.
