## Chapter 3 Themes

Sin brings Consequences

Satan: Anointed Cherub: lost position

Adam: the Earth rebels (thorns)

Eve: physical pain/emotional contention

Cain: eviction, restless, longing

#### Themes

Cain/Abel literal history but also a parable of the two "seeds"

Cain: seed of the serpent (murderer)

Abel "seed of the woman" (Christ)

God now communes from a distance

Firstborn

**Child of Promise** 

Cain

Seth

Ishmael

Isaac

Esau

Jacob

Cain: "gotten"

"with the help of the Lord"

Eve believed in the Lord and the truth of His promise.

Sorrow for awhile – joy in the morning

Abel: "futility", or "vapor"

Keeper of flocks

Why?

"Course of time": regular occurrence (Sabbath?)

"Cain brought an offering"
(believed in God – worshipped God)

#### Themes

Cain/Abel "worship"

Literally: "to be bowed down"

To God's will – not our own, acknowledging our guilt & helplessness

#### 1 Cor. 8:6

yet for us there is one God (not you), the Father, from whom are all things and for whom we exist, and one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom are all things and through whom we exist.

## Themes – Place of Worship

## #1: Specific Place of Worship

They "brought" their offerings

(didn't offer them where they were)

Cain "went out from the Lord's presence"

## Themes – Place of Worship

#### Genesis 3:24

"and He (God) dwelt at the east of the Garden of Eden between the Cherubim, as a shekinah (a 'fire-tongue' or 'fire-sword') to keep open the Tree of Life.

"and at the *end of days* it came to pass that Cain brought ..."

Sabbath Day? Day of rest?

## Themes – Time of Worship

## #3: Method of Worship

This chapter seems to indicate that

Adam & Eve's children had been

instructed in the way to approach God

#### Hebrews 11:4

By faith Abel offered to God a better sacrifice than Cain, through which he was attested to be righteous, God testifying about his gifts, and through faith, though he is dead, he still speaks.

#### How Could Abel Have Had Faith

Romans 10:17 – "Faith cometh by *hearing*, and hearing by the Word of God".

## God's Timeless Principles

Deut. 6:7; 11:19 – "And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.".

## Point of the chapter:

It's not about the men themselves but the difference in their offerings.

"a better sacrifice than Cain" (Heb. 11:4)

- 1. Cain's was bloodless
- Heb. 9:22 "without the shedding of blood..."
  - 2. It was the work of his own hands
  - Gal. 2:16 "works of flesh no one just"
    - 3. Fruit of the ground
    - Gen. 3:17 "Cursed is the ground"

## "The Lord had regard unto Abel and his offering

#### Fire from heaven

Lev. 9:23-24 - And Moses and Aaron went into the tent of meeting, and when they came out they blessed the people, and the glory of the LORD appeared to all the people. And fire came out from before the LORD and consumed the burnt offering and the pieces of fat on the altar, and when all the people saw it, they shouted and fell on their faces.

## Fire from heaven

Lev. 9:24; Judges 6:1;

1 Kings 18:38; 1 Chron. 21:26;

2 Chron. 7:1

### Luke 11:49-51

For this reason also, the wisdom of God said, 'I will send them **prophets** and apostles, and *some* of them they will kill, and some they will persecute, so that the blood of all the prophets, shed since the foundation of the world, may be charged against this generation, from the blood of Abel to the blood of Zechariah, . . . yes, I tell you, it shall be charged against this generation.'

## Angry with God

In effect God is saying to Cain, "hey, why are YOU angry—
I'M the One
who should be angry!

## Sin is crouching at the door:

Pride Envy Hatred
(Satan) (Mankind) (War)
(Adam/Eve) (God) (death)
(Cain) (Abel) (exile)

1 John 3:12 -- We should not be like Cain, who was of the evil one and murdered his brother. And why did he murder him?

Because his own deeds were evil and his brother's righteous.

## Our Application

Approach God the way He prescribes – not in the manner YOU want to approach Him!

#### 1 Samuel 15:22-23

And Samuel said, "Has the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to listen than the fat of rams. For rebellion (like Cain's) is as the sin of divination (witchcraft), and presumption (approach God our own way) is as iniquity and idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of the LORD, he has also rejected you from being king."

## Matthew 15:8-9; Isaiah 29:13

You hypocrites! Well did Isaiah prophesy of you, when he said: 'This people honors me with their lips, but their heart is far from me;

in vain do they worship me, teaching as doctrines the commandments of men."

#### Romans 12:1-2

Therefore I urge you, brothers and sisters, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship.

#### Romans 12:1-2

<sup>2</sup> And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

People have been killing/enslaving others throughout human history in the name of religion.

It's usually not about authentic religious beliefs — it's about justification and control

#### Hebrews 4:10-11

For the one who has entered His rest has himself also rested from his works, as God did from His. Therefore, let us be diligent to enter that rest, so that no one will fall, through following the same example of disobedience. What rest???
